President Hassan Sheikh reached out to the leaders of Turkey, Qatar and Egypt as well as heads of the United Nations and the European Union. This was followed by a diplomatic visit to Egypt where President Hassan Sheikh met with the President of Egypt to discuss security in the region, the fight against terrorism and strengthening cooperation between the two brotherly nations.

"The people and government of Egypt are long-standing allies of Somalia. The fruitful discussions we had today show our commitment to strengthen diplomatic, security and political relations." For his part, the President of Egypt, H.E Abdulfattah Al-Sisi, pointed out the security, socio-economic and political effects of the unlawful actions of the Ethiopian government against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Somalia in the region.

Reading this bill, the Minister of Interior, Federal Affairs and Reconciliation urged members of the Parliament to consider the urgent needs and concerns of Somalia's 3.8 million IDPs.

This Bill submitted by the Ministry of Interior, Federal and Reconciliation was approved by the Federal Cabinet on 27 Oct 2023.




